**PART 2 – EQUIPMENT INSPECTION BY A POLICE OFFICER**

**UNIT A – FOUR-WHEEL MOTOR VEHICLES**

**LIGHTS**

- Headlights (one each side, high and low beams)
- Turn signals (front and rear)
- Taillight (at least one, if equipped with two both must work)
- License plate light
- Brake lights

**INTERIOR**

- Horn
- Bright light indicator
- Windshield wipers
- Windshield washers
- Brakes (adequate to stop and hold the vehicle)
- Parking brake (required on ORV/UTV for on-road use)
- Safety belts (1965 and newer models)

**WINDSHIELD AND MIRRORS**

- Safety Glass (no plexiglass, sufficient size to protect driver and passengers, no cracks, no obstructions, non-transparent material prohibited)
- Outside rearview mirror on driver's side (adjustable)
- Half-ton or more capacity trucks outside rearview mirrors on both sides

**EXTERIOR**

- Bumpers (required on passenger vehicles, 14 to 22 inches above the ground except 4-wheel drive)
- Tires (2/32 inch tread, no exposed cord or tread separation, approved for highway use by D.O.T.)
- Exhaust (good working order, no excessive noise. Must include a tailpipe and resonator where the original design included a tailpipe and resonator)
- Differential gear

Sec. 21-58. Required equipment

In addition to other equipment required by law, every ice cream truck shall be equipped with:

Signal lamps mounted at the same level and as high and as widely spaced laterally as practicable. These lamps shall be five to seven inches in diameter and shall display two alternately flashing amber lights on the front of the vehicles and two alternately flashing red lights on the rear of the vehicle, both lights visible at 500 feet in normal sunlight upon a straight level street.

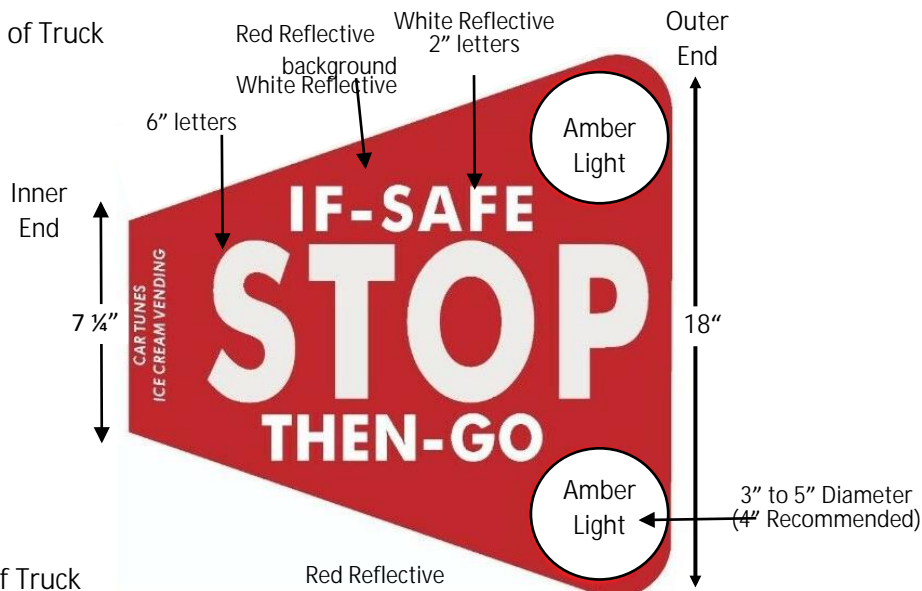
A stop signal arm that can be extended horizontally from the left side of the truck duplicating the design size and specifications shown in subsection (4) of this section. This arm shall be red and white in color and contain two alternately flashing lights three to five inches in diameter, visible at 300 feet to the front and rear in normal sunlight upon a straight level highway. The color of the two lights facing to the front shall be amber and the two lights facing to the rear shall be red. The bottom of the signal arm shall be 42 inches above the highway.

A convex mirror mounted on the front so the driver in the driver's normal seating position can see the area in front of the truck obscured by the hood.

The stop signal arm required by subsection (2) of this section shall be colors to meet specifications in the 1970 Federal Highway Administration Standard Color Charts.
